Global climate governance today is marked by growing complexity with issues including geopolitical tensions, economic downturn, fast green technological development, rising green trade friction, geographically uneven investment and finance, and deepening mistrust among countries,

while multilateralism is facing unprecedented challenges. In July this year, China and the EU issued the Joint Statement on Climate Action by Chinese and EU Leaders, injecting renewed confidence into bilateral and multilateral climate cooperation on the global stage. Looking ahead to the 2025 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP30) in Brazil this November, the international community is focused on advancing the implementation of climate action and forging stronger consensus for cooperation.

Facing these new dynamics, there is an urgent need to enhance the joint leadership for international cooperation, accelerate practical actions by China and the world in addressing the challenges of energy transition, and find a balance among issues of economy, trade, security, and climate to ensure a successful COP30 and steady progress toward the Paris Agreement goals.

CCICED Annual General Meeting has been a platform for open and honest dialogue among all parties and a successful model of multilateralism. Facing the global climate crisis, this forum aims to delve into solutions for international climate cooperation, and China's and global green and low-carbon transition.
